The 1987 Football season was a banner year for the Red Raiders. The team became the first in Hornell since 1920 to go undefeated and untied, posting a 10-0 record. This year's team was also the first in Hornell to bring home the Section V Title, by beating East Rochester in the Class "A" Championship game by a score of 21-14. The team, under Coach Mastin, was led by 14 seniors, including Co-captains Jeff Walsh (Section V Class "A" MVP), D.J. Capluzzi (Outstanding Lineman in the Championship Game), Bob Northup (Most Valuable Offensive Back in the Championship Game), and Chris Secondo (who led the defense all year).

The Raiders scored 285 points this season, while giving up only 41 points in the ten games. The Hornell defense allowed only two touchdowns all season.

One thing I love about Hornell is that the people are so friendly and open for other cultures. I've felt at home from the very beginning in August and it wasn't hard at all to adjust to your life.
