#### Colophon

The 1995 <u>Maple Leaf</u>, Volume #60 was published by the Taylor Publishing Company of Dallas, Texas. The publishing representative was Mrs. Barabara Stock-slader and the Customer Service Representative was Ms. Tina Avery. Taylor Publishing Company printed a total of 711 copies of the 192 page book. Each ordered copy of the book cost \$25.00 plus \$2.00 for the name to be imprinted in foil on the cover. Funds for the 1995 <u>Maple Leaf</u> Yearbook, which had a manufacturing cost of \$36.45 per copy, included three school dances, concession stand operations for 11 public events at Maple City Park, advertising sales, and private contributions from faculty, parents, and local businesses.

The custom designed and embossed cover was created by the 1995 Maple Leaf Yearbook Staff under the advisement of Mr. Don Dempsy, Graphic Designer for Taylor Publishing Company. The Smyth sewn cover was gold foil stamped in Times Roman standard type, on #452 Blue colored, water grain textured cover, with a rounded and backed binding. Pages for the 9x12 inch book were printed on 100 pound, enamel-coated paper. Of the 192 pages, 34 were printed using the 4-color process, the 8 division pages and 6 pages in the "Faculty Section" were printed with purple #071 in the spot color process. The type fonts used throughout the book included Times Roman, Jefferson Script, American Typewriter, and Garamond Condensed.

The Lauren Studio Company of Rochester, New York was responsible for all Senior Portraits, group/team photography, and all photo processing and enlarge-


ments. Underclassmen and Faculty portraits were taken by Delmar School Portraits of Rochester, New York. Candid photographs in all sections were taken by <u>Maple Leaf</u> staff photographers and their advisor Mr. Peter J. Hens. Photographs for the "Current Events" Section were provided by the Associated Press of New York, New York, R.M. Photo Services, Inc., of New York, New York, and the <u>Evening Tribune</u> of Hornell, New York-a subsidiary of the American Publishing Company of New York.

The entire yearbook production used Page Vision 6.5 and Type Vision 6.5 under permission and distribution of the Taylor Publishing Company. The theme Passport was created originally by the 1995 <a href="Maple-Leaf">Maple-Leaf</a> Yearbook Staff during the July 1994 Yearbook Conference/Workshop at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, New York, sponsored by the Taylor Publishing Company. The <a href="Maple-Leaf">Maple-Leaf</a> Yearbook Staff was the proud recipient for the "1994 Taylor Seminar Award, for original design and presentation". The Passport cover, theme, division pages, and endsheets were approved for use by the United States Government, Office of Special Affairs, on August 9, 1994.


