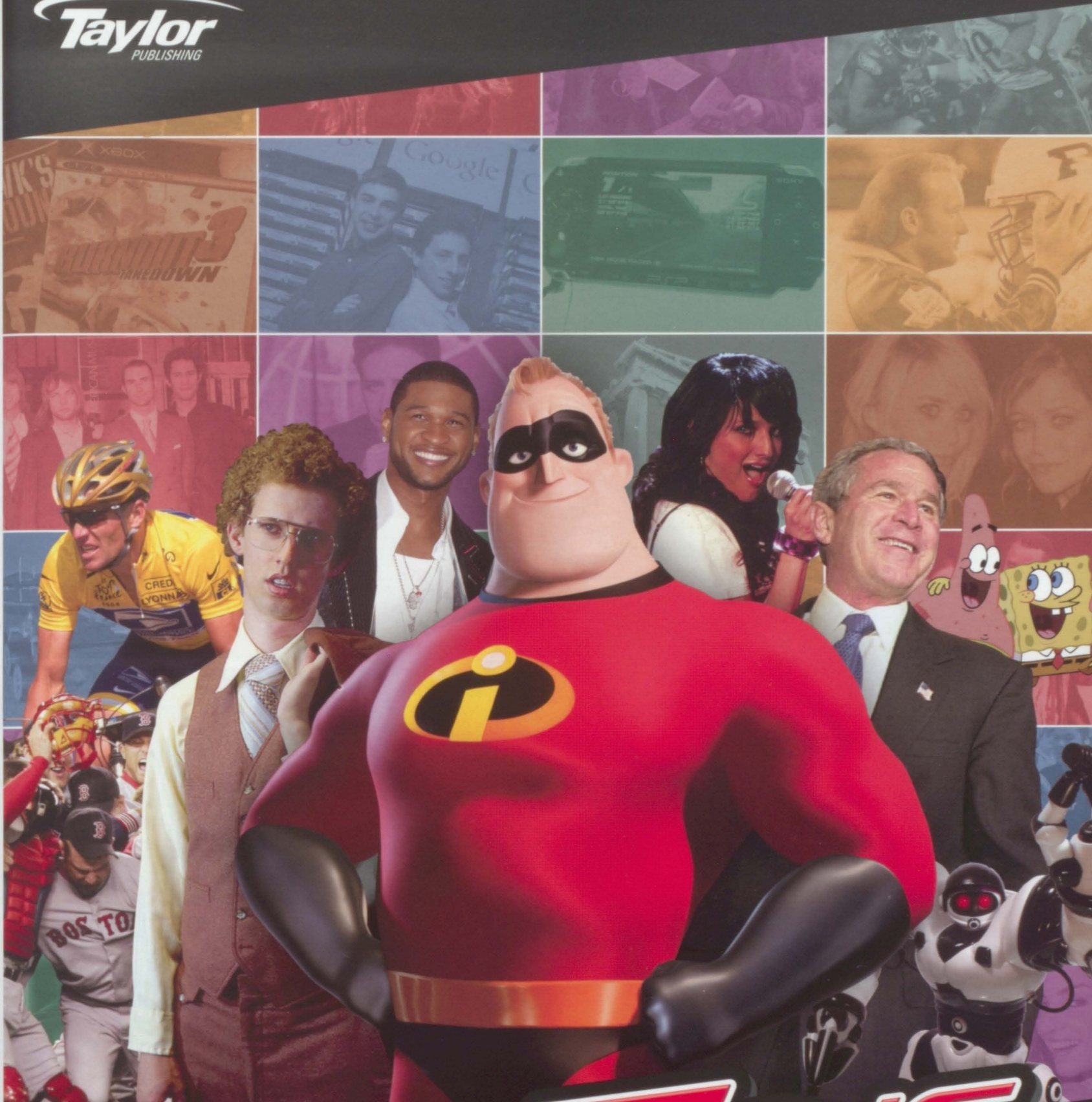
The 2005 Maple Leaf Volume 71 was published by the Taylor Publishing Company of Dallas, Texas. The customer service representative was Ms. Tracy Juarez, the sales representative was Mrs. Barbara Stockslader and the advisors were Mr. Mark Labanoski and Mrs. Janet Crowley. A total of 350 copies were printed of the 192 page book. Single copies were priced at \$40.00. Funds for the 2004 Maple Leaf, which had manufacturing costs of over \$65.00 a book, were obtained through advertising sales, numerous concession stand operations at Maple City Park events, and private donations.

The cover was designed in the summer of 2004 by the Maple Leaf Yearbook Staff in coordination with Taylor Cover Department. The Smyth-sewn, lexotoned cover was embossed, debossed and foil-stamped by Taylor Publishing, and featured a rounded and backed binding. The 208 pages of the 9x12 annual were printed on 80# matte finish paper, featuring 48 pages printed in the 4-color process. The main type-faces used throughout the book were chosen from Taylor Publishing's Finesse and Calligrapher families.

Photographs for the senior portraits, group and team photos and all processing used in the book were completed by Lauren Studios of Rochester, NY. Underclassmen portraits were photographed, processed and distributed by Upstate Portraits of Webster, NY. All other photography was the responsibility of the 2004 Maple Leaf staff, 90% of which were done using digital cameras.

The entire yearbook was created on the Elitevision software under the permission of Taylor Publishing on a Dell computer system. Original layout and copy were designed solely by the Maple Leaf staff. The theme "Inside the Rotunda" was developed by the staff during summer 2004 meetings.

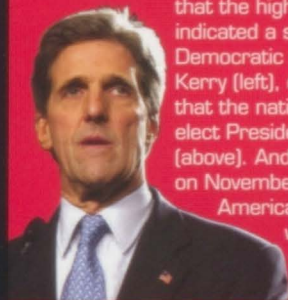

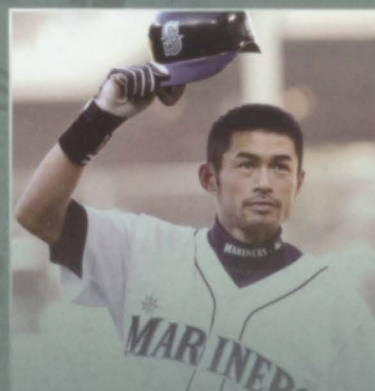

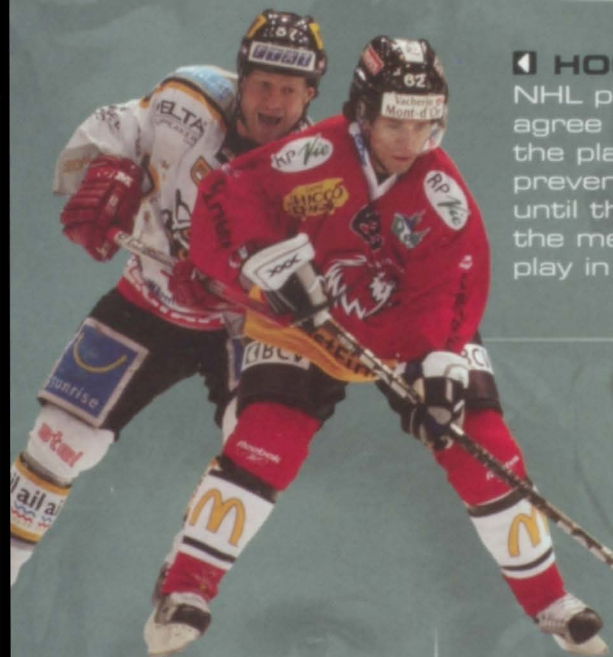

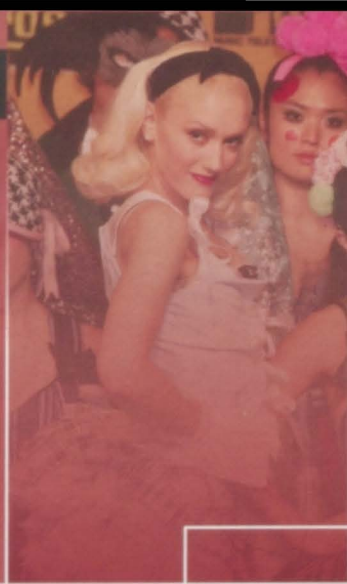
